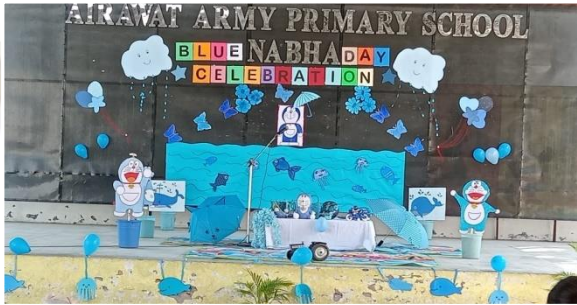


Students expressed their gratitude and admiration for their teachers through heartfelt speech, poems, songs and dance performances.
